

Subject Local homeless prevention aid modifications

Overview

H.F. 4561 repeals the sunset of local homeless prevention aid, allows Tribal governments to choose to not spend all or a portion of the aid, and clarifies that any money unspent by a county goes back into the county appropriation in the following year and that any money unspent by a Tribal government goes back into the Tribal government appropriation in the following year. This bill also modifies the reporting requirements for the aid, pushing back the months in which reporting and reports are required to be submitted.

| 1 | <p>Use of proceeds.</p> <p>Allows Tribal governments to choose not to spend all or a portion of aid distributions they receive, something counties currently can do. This section also contains a conforming change related to the repeal of the sunset in section 4.</p> |
| 2 | <p>Appropriation.</p> <p>Clarifies that any money unspent by counties in one year is added to the county appropriation in the following year and that any money unspent by a Tribal government is added to the Tribal government appropriation in the following year.</p> |
| 3 | <p>Report.</p> <p>Moves from December to January the month in which counties and Tribal governments must report to the commissioner of revenue uses of aid. This section also moves from January to March the month in which the commissioner of revenue must submit to the legislature the biannual report on local homeless prevention aid. This section also contains a conforming change related to the repeal of the sunset in section 4.</p> |

Section	Description
4	Repealer. Removes the sunset on local homeless prevention aid. Under current law, the aid will sunset after aids payable in 2028.
