Bill Description

This bill authorizes an ongoing \$500,000 per year appropriation from the general fund to the commissioner of health to support grants for comprehensive, trauma-informed, and culturally specific services for victims of labor trafficking and labor exploitation.

Assumptions

MDH assumes that we will issue 4 grants at \$125,000 each per year to serve victims of labor trafficking and labor exploitation. Based on our experience with the Safe Harbor Program, MDH will require 0.2 FTE Management Analyst to develop and submit requests for proposals (RFPs), and to process contracts (invoices, oversight).
