Analysis of H.F. 3763 (Kiel) / S.F. 3474 (Johnson)

The city of East Grand Forks previously imposed a sales and use tax of 1% from 2018 to 2020.

The bill authorizes the city of East Grand Forks to impose a sales and use tax of 1.25%, if approved by the voters at a general election. The proceeds would be used to finance \$23,343,000 for the remodeling of the Civic Center Sports Complex and \$13,756,000 for the remodeling of the VFW Memorial and Blue Line Arena.

The bill authorizes a bond issuance of up to \$37.099 million plus bond costs. The tax would terminate at the earlier of 20 years after the tax is first imposed or when the city council determines that sufficient funds have been received to pay for the costs of the project and bonds. The tax may expire earlier if the city so determines by ordinance.

The bill would have no impact on state taxes.
