- Support and sustain Community Solutions Fund for Healthy Child Development to allow community members to identify solutions to managing and address issues and challenges addressing families.
- Support for voluntary Family Home Visiting services for every infant to improve maternal and child
 outcomes and address the mental health needs of parents, child and families as well as provide
 continued support for housing, food and employment
- 3. Support **Healthy Beginnings**, **Healthy Families** to increase knowledge and access to early childhood services, address infant mortality and assist children who have justice involved parents.
- 4. Expansion of **mental health** services and support the workforce.
- 5. Support for **lead testing, remediation, and grants for elevated blood levels** to prevent future harm to young children.
