1.18 Page 6, line 25, before the period, insert "except that the commissioner of human services  
1.19 or a managed care organization retains authority to make determinations related to the  
1.20 medical necessity and clinical appropriateness of a placement"

1.21 Page 7, after line 11, insert:

1.22 "EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective January 1, 2022."

1.23 Page 7, after line 19, insert:

1.24 "EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective January 1, 2022."
