

- In that time, we only closed financing on 7,762 new units.²


Loss of Rental Units Affordable at 60% AMI Twin Cities 7-County Metro Area, 2013-2019












St. Cloud NOAH Housing

NOAH: Market Rate Properties with Units Renting at or Below 60% of AMI in Saint Cloud, 2022





NOAH: Market Rate Properties with Units Renting at or Below 60% of AMI in Moorhead





NOAH: Market Rate Properties with Units Renting at or Below 60% of AMI in Mankato, 2022











MN Housing Partnership, State of the State's Housing 2021
