## COMMITTEE ON RULES AND LEGISLATIVE ADMINISTRATION 1 2 Resolution on Reimbursement of Member Communications Expenses 3 4 BE IT RESOLVED, by the Committee on Rules and Legislative Administration, that during 5 the sessions and interims of the 92nd Legislature each member of the House of Representatives 6 may receive, upon written request, a communication expense allowance to efficiently conduct 7 8 legislative business. A Member may request an allowance up to \$125 per month for internet services, an 9 additional residential telephone line, optional telephone services, wireless services; or any other 10 communication expenses needed to maintain frequent and reliable communication with 11 constituents, House staff and other government officials. 12 Members may request payment by submitting a signed, written request to House Budget & 13 Accounting within 90 days from the end of the month or quarter in which payment is requested, 14 and may at their discretion submit a receipt for actual costs up to the amount of the allowance. 15 PROVIDED FURTHER, that during the sessions and interims of the 92nd Legislature each 16 member of the House of Representatives must be reimbursed for the cost of long-distance 17 telephone calls made for legislative business and official duties of the office. Requests must be 18 submitted to House Budget and Accounting within 90 days from the end of the month in which 19 payment is requested and must be accompanied by an itemized long-distance phone bill on 20 which the member indicates the legislative calls for which reimbursement is requested. 21 PROVIDED FURTHER, that during the 2021 session and the month of June 2021, each 22 member of the House of Representatives may be reimbursed up to \$20 per month for a monthly 23 Zoom Pro license subscription purchased for legislative business and official duties of the office. 24 Requests must be submitted to House Budget and Accounting within 90 days from the end of the 25 month in which payment is requested and must be accompanied by a receipt. 26
