- 1. It is time to restore access to driver's licenses for immigrants; we expect our elected leaders to stand up for the rights of all immigrants.
  - We had them before and they were taken as a distraction. Minnesotans are ready to right our wrong. Minnesotans are greater than fear and our care for community is stronger.
