Overview

This bill modifies a referendum provision for local Public Utility Commissions, modifies the powers of the Lake City Port Authority, and changes the term length of Red Wing Port Authority appointees.

| 1 | <p>Change in membership; procedures.</p> <p>Applies a referendum-by-petition requirement when there is any change in the size of a local Public Utilities Commission.</p> <p>Effective the day following final enactment.</p> |
| 2 | <p>Lake City.</p> <p>Modifies the Lake City Port Authority powers by removing authority to issue debt or bonds and to exercise the power of eminent domain. The port authority may request the city of Lake City to levy a tax on its behalf, but the city may grant or deny the request.</p> <p>Effective the day following final enactment.</p> |
| 3 | <p>Term of members.</p> <p>Changes the term length for a Red Wing Port Authority appointee from three years to six years.</p> <p>Effective the day after the city of Red Wing and its chief clerical officer comply with the requirements for special laws.</p> |

4	<p data-bbox="316 262 1429 294">City of Lake City; validation of prior act.</p> <p data-bbox="316 304 1429 420">Authorizes the city of Lake City to file local approval with the secretary of state for a 2021 special law, which authorized the city to establish a port authority, by January 1, 2027. Validates actions taken by the city to date pursuant to the special law.</p> <p data-bbox="316 451 1429 491">Effective the day following final enactment.</p>
