## **Cost Comparison**

House 2022 – Cost to Build \$177,945 Appraisal: \$239,000

House 2021 – Cost to Build \$146,115 Appraisal: \$179,000

House 2019 – Cost to Build \$ 98,992 Appraisal: \$114,000

## City of Little Falls Housing Study

- 2-4 new houses each year for next five years in low-moderate price range such as those built by Habitat for Humanity
- Changed city policy to reduce permit fees for new single-family dwellings built by nonprofits
- SAC/WAC fees not eligible for reduction

## **Morrison County**

- 1. Pursue tax-forfeited properties
- 2. Policy change needed to eliminate barrier through city governments
