1.9	decertification of a tax increment district, the school district's aid and levy limitations must
1.10	be adjusted for the fiscal year in which the excess tax increment is paid under the provisions

The school district must use the payment 2.28 of excess tax increment to replace the aid and levy revenue reduced under this subdivision. 2.29
