1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 297H.13, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 2. Allocation of revenues. (a) <del>\$33,760,000, or 70 percent, whichever is greater,</del>
1.8	Of the amounts remitted under this chapter must be, the percentage credited to the
1.9	environmental fund established in section 16A.531, subdivision 1, must be increased in
1.10	equal increments beginning in fiscal year 2024 to reach 100 percent in fiscal year 2026 and
1.11	thereafter.
1.12	(b) The remainder in fiscal years 2024 and 2025 must be deposited into the general fund.
1.13	(c) Beginning in fiscal year 2024 and continuing each year thereafter, the difference
1.14	between the amount deposited in the environmental fund under paragraph (a) and the amount
