

**Subject** Private security training requirements

## Overview

This bill increases the preservice and continuing training requirements for persons who provide security services. The bill also creates five tiers of security services and prescribes the level of training that persons working within those tiers must receive.

Section	Description
1	<p><b>Rules.</b></p> <p>Para (a). Clarifies who must be trained to the standards established by the Private Detective and Protective Agent Board (the board).</p> <p>Para (b). Specifies additional training requirements for persons licensed by the board and persons that license holders employ.</p> <p>Para (c). Requires the board to develop an implementation plan for the additional training requirements established in paragraph (b).</p>
2	<p><b>Classification of duties for protective agents and employees; training.</b></p> <p>Establishes five security service tiers to classify protective agents and their employees who provide security services. Requires persons providing security services at a given tier to be trained to standards established for that tier.</p>
3	<p><b>Required contents.</b></p> <p>Modifies the preservice training hours that persons providing security services must complete. Makes additional conforming changes.</p>
4	<p><b>Proprietary employers.</b></p> <p>Requires employees of proprietary employers who provide security services to meet the training requirements established for the tier of security service that they are assigned to provide.</p>



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
