This bill modifies the World's Best Workforce performance measures and reporting requirements.

Summary

Section Description

1 Definitions.

Defines "on track for graduation" to mean that a student is on track if at the end of grade 9, the student has earned at least five credits and has received no more than one failing grade in a semester in a course in language, arts, math, science, or social studies.

2 Performance measures.

Adds performance measures in a district's World's Best Workforce plan to include (1) participation in honors or gifted and talented programming and (2) students on track for graduation. Requires districts to report on participation and performance on advanced placement, international baccalaureate, and dual enrollment programs. Requires reporting on performance measures for student subgroups.
