Overview

This bill adds certain interagency groups as public bodies subject to the Minnesota Open Meeting Law (OML). Conforming changes are made throughout the bill.

All sections of the bill would be effective the day following final enactment.

Summary

Section	Description
1	In executive branch, local government. Adds an interagency group of state employees making recommendations regarding permitting decisions of a public body to the list of public bodies subject to the OML.
2	Votes to be kept in journal or minutes. Conforming change to add interagency groups to the vote recording requirements provision under the OML.
3	Application. Applies the authority for state entity meetings conducted by telephone or interactive technology to interagency groups.
