- protecting the confidentiality of an election official’s personal information or their family or household member home address,
- providing for criminal and civil penalties for violations, and
- the scope and breadth of recognized violations.

It is no secret that not all Minnesotans experience democracy in the same way and that democracy works best when every eligible member can participate. That is why we are working to improve every step of the electoral process — supporting reforms that facilitate access to the ballot box for eligible voters regardless of zip codes, race/ethnicity, or socio-economic backgrounds, and working with election administrators to ensure voting systems and machines are safe and reliable. HF3666 ensures the safety of Minnesota election officials who are the very backbone of our elections.
