The mission of the Little Lakers Childcare Center is to foster age-appropriate learning and provide exceptional child care in a safe, nurturing environment.

A goal of the center is to be an asset to the community and to partner with the school district, in-home family childcare providers, local businesses, and the Lake Crystal Area Recreation Center to enhance our community.

Purpose

- 2016 Study found a shortage of over 90 childcare spots in the Lake Crystal area
- Businesses have reported challenges in recruiting employees over a concern for available childcare
- Center will serve as a training facility for other independent in-home providers and provide job opportunities for individuals seeking employment in the Childcare field
- Full capacity will serve approximately 88 children
- Board is made up of members from the Lake Crystal community
- The nonprofit center has secured a building, that may have otherwise been vacant, with needs including: renovations to meet codes for licensing, equipment, & staff hiring and training

Community

- Lake Crystal is a growing community with recent expansions to the Elementary and Secondary schools
- Home sales remain strong with amenities including a strong school system, close proximity to Mankato, and excellent recreational facilities.

Fundraising Efforts

- Recipient of the Otto Bremer Grant of \$45,000.00
- Donations & pledges from local businesses and individuals have been collected
- Partnering with First Children's Family Finance to apply for USDA financing
- Requesting a grant from the legislature for equipment and start-up costs for operating a childcare center.
