Overview

This bill makes blank appropriations in fiscal year 2023 for lead testing and remediation in drinking water and to add information about the locations of lead service lines to the state auditor's infrastructure stress transparency tool. The infrastructure stress transparency tool is an interactive mapping tool that contains data on sewer systems and drinking water systems in the state.

Summary

Section Description

1 Testing for and remediation of lead in drinking water at certain facilities; appropriation.

Makes a blank appropriation in fiscal year 2023 from the general fund to the commissioner of health to test for lead in drinking water from private wells, day care facilities, and rental properties, and to remediate contamination where found. Provides that this section does not require a property owner or lessee to submit to drinking water testing.

2 Infrastructure transparency tool upgrades; appropriation.

Makes a blank appropriation in fiscal year 2023 from the general fund to the state auditor to add information about the location of lead service lines to the infrastructure stress transparency tool.
