Amends the definition of compounding in the Pharmacy Practice Act to specify compounding does not include the use of a flavoring agent to flavor a drug. (Compounding means preparing, mixing, assembling, packaging, and labeling a drug for an identified individual patient as a result of a prescription drug order, and also includes anticipatory compounding and the preparation of drugs in which all components are nonprescription substances.)</p> |
| 2 | <p>Flavoring agent.</p> <p>Adds subd. 44 to § 151.01. Defines flavoring agent in the Pharmacy Practice Act as a substance made up of inactive ingredients and added to a drug to improve the drug's taste.</p> |
