

NON-RESIDENT PERMITS- 31 TO 60 DAYS SF 1322/ HF 1219

WHAT THIS BILL DOES:

Changes the 31-day non-resident permits to 60 days, to better facilitate the sale of vehicles to out of state customers and removal of vehicles from Minnesota.

WHY THIS BILL IS NEEDED:

The current 31-day permit is not always sufficient for out of state customers to get their vehicles titled and registered in their home states, which causes complications for lenders and dealers.

ADJACENT STATE DEALERS ACCESS TO EVTR SF 1321/ HF 1220

WHAT THIS BILL DOES:

Allows a motor vehicle dealer licensed in an adjacent state to access the Electronic Vehicle Titling and Registration (EVTR) interface.

WHY THIS BILL IS NEEDED:

Many dealer groups own dealerships in border communities and serve Minnesota customers. The EVTR interface reduces manual paperwork and processes and allows customers to get their license plates on the spot.
