Dear Chair, Rep Cheryl Youakim, Vice Chair, Rep Mary Frances Clardy, and Members of the Mn House School Finance Committee:

I am actively promoting HF2492 for the following reasons: As a cardiologist, I know that you and I are healthy not so much because of the health services that I provide, but because we have an education, and with that education we can generate adequate income.

When we keep a young person from becoming homeless, Mn Dept of Health research shows their life expectancy deficit of 20 to 30 years is erased. Youthbuild puts them on a path to health and well-being.

In addition to providing low cost home ownership opportunities for low income families, this bill allows youth to enter a training and employment stream that provides them with an opportunity to earn a respectable income, also an essential building block for health. Students who build homes for others will be acquiring the skills that give them *respect, dignity, meaning and purpose*—critical building blocks for well-being that homeless youth lack.

A young person will be able to drive by a home and say, "I built that! I made it possible for that family to own a home! I contributed to my community! The power of these words to create well-being cannot be overstated.
