One of the most frustrating things I saw as a law enforcement officer was the dismissing, plea bargaining of gun cases in Hennepin, and Ramsey Co.. When we find a gun on a juvenile or young adult, or a car with 8 people in it with 6 guns, to actually prosecute them for all gun crimes requesting a mandatory minimum, instead of plea bargaining out or not prosecuting.
