First Moves brings quality arts education to first graders through their Physical Education curriculum to enhance PE standards and empower PE teachers to incorporate dance vocabulary and concepts into their PE curriculum.

First Moves embeds professional teaching artists from the Cowles' roster of dancers into the classroom; and also includes professional development training for elementary PE teachers, empowering them to incorporate dance vocabulary and concepts into ongoing curriculum. By deploying the program across an entire grade-band, city wide, First Moves drives systemic changes in school culture through incorporating dance vocabulary and concepts into PE curriculum, and creating opportunities for all first grade students to dance.
