This bill requires health plans, Medical Assistance, and MinnesotaCare to cover the treatment of ectodermal dysplasias, including reconstructive breast surgery, hair prostheses, and dental services.

(a) Requires health plans to include coverage for dental treatments related to ectodermal dysplasias, including bone grafts, dental implants, orthodontia, dental prosthodontics, and dental maintenance.</p> <p>(b) Clarifies that if a dental treatment is covered under a dental plan the coverage under paragraph (a) is secondary.</p> |

Effective date. This section is effective January 1, 2023.

4 Ectodermal dysplasias.

Requires Medical assistance and MinnesotaCare to cover treatment for ectodermal dysplasias, including the coverages described in sections 1 to 3. Clarifies that this subdivision applies to fee-for-service, managed care plans, county-based purchasing plans, and integrated health partnerships.

Effective date. This section is effective January 1, 2023.
