

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 3363 as follows:

1.2 Page 6, delete section 7 and insert:

1.3 "**Sec. 7. REDACTING STREET ADDRESSES; REPORTS AND STATEMENTS**
1.4 **ON BOARD'S WEBSITE.**

1.5 (a) Within seven calendar days of the effective date of this section, the Campaign Finance
1.6 and Public Disclosure Board must remove from the board's website all reports and statements
1.7 that were filed in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 10A.04, 10A.09, 10A.20, or
1.8 10A.202. The board must redact or omit private or nonpublic data from each statement or
1.9 report and repost the report to the board's website. The board must prioritize its work on
1.10 reports and statements in the following order:

1.11 (1) reports and statements from candidates;

1.12 (2) reports and statements from party units;

1.13 (3) reports and statements from political committees, political funds, independent
1.14 expenditure funds, and ballot funds; and

1.15 (4) all other statements and filings.

1.16 When the board completes its work with statements and reports from a category above, the
1.17 board must post the reports and statements on the board's website.

1.18 (b) The board must have all reports and statements reposted within six months of the
1.19 effective date of this section. If the board is unable to comply with this timeline, the board
1.20 must report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with
1.21 jurisdiction over campaign finance policy why compliance was not possible, what issues
1.22 must be resolved in order for the board to be in compliance, and when the board anticipates
1.23 it will be able to comply.
