Subject: Request to Include Senate A-4 Amendment Language in HF2434

Dear Co-Chairs Noor and Schomacker,

There has been a significant and harmful change in language in HF2434 which contradicts the amendment's purpose.

Adopting the HF2434 language, as is, would result in a significant taxpayer increase as it will take away self-direction of waiver funds and force people to use expensive nursing service agencies.

My daughter, 27, has self-directed CAC (Community Alternative Care) waiver services. We have successfully self-directed skilled care in our home for over 18 years. They are the only way to responsibly use taxpayer funds to provide skilled care in your home. People must be able to self-direct ALL care as they do now.

REMOVE/MODIFY from HF2434 as it does not mention self-direction:

64.28 If any of the requirements outlined in paragraph (c) are no longer met following a person's annual reassessment under section 256B.0911, the commissioner must terminate the budget exception. Lead agencies must require documentation to ensure that all home care nursing services authorized under this budget exception are used for home care nursing services and not used to fund nonhome care nursing services.

I would be grateful if you would work with your colleagues and staff to **remove this restrictive** clause from HF2434 and pass the original language in the A-4 amendment stemming from the Senate.

Language from Senate File 3054 to Replicate in the House File 2434:

The commissioner must develop **an individualized budget methodology exception to support access to self-directed home care nursing services**. Lead agencies must submit budget exception requests to the commissioner in a manner identified by the commissioner. Eligibility for the budget exception in this paragraph is limited to persons meeting all of the following criteria in the person's most recent assessment: Thank you for your leadership and for your ongoing commitment to the dignity and inclusion of people with disabilities in Minnesota.
