1.2 Policy to which was referred:

1.3 H. F. No. 1040, A bill for an act relating to solid waste; requiring product stewardship
1.4 program for wind and solar infrastructure; providing for fee on retail sales of wind and solar
1.5 infrastructure; establishing moratorium on disposal of wind and solar energy infrastructure
1.6 in landfills; requiring a report; appropriating money; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024,
1.7 sections 13.7411, subdivision 4; 115A.142; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota
1.8 Statutes, chapter 115A.

1.9 Reported the same back with the following amendments:

1.10 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.11 "Section 1. [115A.9563] WIND AND SOLAR ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE
1.12 DISPOSAL; PROHIBITION.

1.13 (a) For the purposes of this section, "wind and solar energy infrastructure" means:

1.14 (1) solar photovoltaic modules or system installation components; or

1.15 (2) wind energy conversion systems or wind energy conversion system components.

1.16 (b) No person may place wind and solar energy infrastructure:

1.17 (1) in mixed municipal solid waste;

1.18 (2) in a solid waste processing or disposal facility that is not a recycling facility; or

1.19 (3) in or on the land.

1.20 (c) This section may be enforced under sections 115.071 and 116.072.

1.21 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."

1.22 Delete the title and insert:

1.23 "A bill for an act
1.24 relating to solid waste; restricting disposal of wind and solar energy infrastructure;
1.25 proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 115A."
