1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to education; striking obsolete language pertaining to the administration
1.3 of the Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board; amending Minnesota
1.4 Statutes 2022, section 122A.07, subdivision 4a.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 122A.07, subdivision 4a, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 4a. Administration. (a) The executive director of the board shall be the chief
1.8 administrative officer for the board but shall not be a member of the board. The executive
1.9 director shall maintain the records of the board, account for all fees received by the board,
1.10 supervise and direct employees servicing the board, and perform other services as directed
1.11 by the board.

1.12 (b) The Department of Administration must provide administrative support in accordance
1.13 with section 16B.371. The commissioner of administration must assess the board for services
1.14 it provides under this section.

1.15 (c) The Department of Education must provide suitable offices and other space to the
1.16 board at reasonable cost until January 1, 2020. Thereafter, the board may contract with
1.17 either the Department of Education or the Department of Administration for the provision
1.18 of suitable offices and other space, joint conference and hearing facilities, and examination
1.19 rooms.
