- 2.18 Page 10, after line 22, insert:
- 2.19 "Sec. 7. **RULEMAKING; INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.**
- 2.20 By January 1, 2028, the commissioner of public safety must adopt rules to implement
2.21 Minnesota Statutes, section 171.308, using the exempt rulemaking process under Minnesota
2.22 Statutes, section 14.386. Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 14.386, paragraph
2.23 (b), a rule adopted under this section is permanent. After the rule is adopted, the authorization
2.24 to use the exempt rulemaking process expires."
- 2.25 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references
- 2.26 With the recommendation that when so amended the bill be re-referred to the Committee
2.27 on Judiciary Finance and Civil Law.
