Bill Description

HF118-0 permits complaints in certain forfeiture matters to be served by certified mail and permits statements of claim in certain forfeiture matters to be served pursuant to the Rules of Conciliation Court Procedure.

Assumptions

It is assumed this bill clarifies the Rules of Conciliation Court Procedure apply when a claimant files a demand for a judicial determination of a forfeiture under Minn. Stat. § 169A.63, subd. 8 to be heard in conciliation court.

It is assumed this bill clarifies service of a demand for a judicial determination of a forfeiture to be heard in district court pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 609.5314, subd. 3 may be served by certified mail, and if the forfeiture proceeding is filed in conciliation court, the Rules of Conciliation Court Procedure apply.

It is assumed court forms will require changes.

Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula

It is assumed this bill will have minimal impact on the Minnesota Judicial Branch, and any impact will be absorbed by the Branch.
