	With over 22,000 members, the Minnesota Nurses Association (MNA) is the leading organization representing professional nursing across Minnesota. As leaders in labor and health care, we are a voice for hospital nurses around the state on issues related to the health and well-being of the public.
	We want to thank Representative Bierman for authoring HF402, which would establish new regulations to prevent massive, profit-driven conglomerates from further corporatizing and consolidating the state healthcare system. Among other provisions, there are several items in the bill that MNA is particularly supportive of:
	 Parameters and authorities established to help safeguard Minnesotans against transactions that would lead to negative impacts relating to the affordability, accessibility, and quality of healthcare services; Language to explicitly prohibit transactions that would create a monopoly or monopsony;
	 Prohibiting CEOs, board members, or other healthcare entity executives from personally profiting off a merger or other transaction; and Extending the moratorium on HMO conversion, and requiring the state to gather findings and develop longer-term strategies around HMO conversion.
	MNA strongly supports HF402, as amended, but we would also strongly request that the Legislature and author to consider future amendments that would:
