Overview

This bill appropriates money to the commissioner of health for distribution to local and Tribal public health organizations for emergency preparedness and response capabilities.

Summary

Section Description

1 Appropriation; local and Tribal public health emergency preparedness and response.

Appropriates \$9,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 from the general fund to the commissioner of health to be distributed to local and Tribal public health organizations for emergency preparedness and response capabilities. Requires 90 percent of the appropriation to be distributed to public health organizations, and allows the department to use ten percent of the appropriation for administrative costs. Requires uses of the appropriation to align with national standards in a CDC report on public health emergency preparedness and response capabilities.
