Overview

This bill appropriates money for customized living quality improvement grants, which are competitive grants provided to certain MA waiver providers to: (1) provide more efficient, higher quality services; (2) encourage home and community-based services providers to innovate; (3) equip home and community-based services providers with organizational tools and expertise to improve their quality; (4) incentivize home and community-based services; and (5) disseminate successful performance improvement strategies statewide.

Appropriates \$1,000,000 in each year of the 2022-2023 biennium from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for customized living quality improvement grants.
