## 1 Authorized activities.

Amends § 156.12, subd. 2. Amends a subdivision authorizing individuals to provide certain care or assistance to animals without being licensed by the Board of Veterinary Medicine, to allow emergency medical personnel certified by the Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board to provide emergency medical care to a police dog wounded in the line of duty, without being licensed by the Board of Veterinary Medicine.
