

1.1 Franson and Lee, F., from the Committee on Capital Investment to which was referred:

1.2 H. F. No. 2418, A bill for an act relating to capital investment; requiring local
1.3 governments to establish capital project plans; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota
1.4 Statutes, chapter 16A.

1.5 Reported the same back with the following amendments:

1.6 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.7 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 16A.86, subdivision 3a, is amended to read:

1.8 Subd. 3a. **Information provided.** All requests for state assistance under this section
1.9 must include the following information:

1.10 (1) the name of the political subdivision that will own the capital project for which state
1.11 assistance is being requested;

1.12 (2) the public purpose of the project;

1.13 (3) the extent to which the political subdivision has or expects to provide local, private,
1.14 user financing, or other nonstate funding for the project;

1.15 (4) a list of the bondable activities that the project encompasses; examples of bondable
1.16 activities are public improvements of a capital nature for land acquisition, predesign, design,
1.17 construction, and furnishing and equipping for occupancy;

1.18 (5) whether the project will require new or additional state operating subsidies;

1.19 (6) whether the governing body of the political subdivision requesting the project has
1.20 passed a resolution in support of the project and has established priorities for all projects
1.21 within its jurisdiction for which bonding appropriations are requested when submitting
1.22 multiple requests;

2.1 (7) whether the political subdivision has a plan for maintenance and preservation of the
2.2 project, including safety and security, maintenance and utility costs, availability of repair
2.3 parts and materials, sustainability, and any other criteria the political subdivision deems
2.4 relevant;

2.5 ~~(7)~~ (8) if the project requires a predesign under section 16B.335, whether the predesign
2.6 has been completed at the time the capital project request is submitted, and whether the
2.7 political subdivision has submitted the project predesign to the commissioner of
2.8 administration for review and approval; and

2.9 ~~(8)~~ (9) if applicable, the information required under section 473.4485, subdivision 1a.

2.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2027."

2.11 Delete the title and insert:

2.12 "A bill for an act
2.13 relating to capital investment; modifying information to be provided for capital
2.14 project grants to political subdivisions; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section
2.15 16A.86, subdivision 3a."

2.16 With the recommendation that when so amended the bill be placed on the General
2.17 Register.
