Summary

This bill establishes a process that would apply when a company that registers a pesticide with the Minnesota Department of Agriculture (MDA) subsequently elects to immediately cancel the registration.

H.F. 4082 would grant MDA authority to immediately cancel a product registration upon request. When requesting immediate cancellation, the registrant would be required to submit to MDA a statement that the product is no longer in distribution, along with certain supporting documentation.
