- 1.2 Data on expenditure of money from the bond proceeds fund, the environmental and
- 1.3 natural resources trust fund, the outdoor heritage fund, the clean water fund, the parks
- 1.4 and trails fund, and the arts and cultural heritage fund must be made available on the Web
- 1.5 in a manner that allows the public to obtain information about a project receiving an
- 1.6 appropriation by clicking on a map. To the extent feasible, the map must include or link to
- 1.7 information about each project, including but not limited to, the location, the name of the
- 1.8 entity receiving the appropriation, the source of the appropriation, the amount of money
- 1.9 received, and a general statement of the purpose of the appropriation. The Legislative
- 1.10 Coordinating Commission, the commissioner of administration, and the commissioner
- 1.11 of management and budget must collaborate to ensure compliance with this section in a
- 1.12 manner that provides data cost-effectively in a way that is easy for the public to use. The
- 1.13 commissioner of management and budget must determine the cost for the commissioner
- 1.14 and entities collaborating with the commissioner to comply with this section, and to
- 1.15 the extent feasible, must assess each fund subject to this section a proportional share of
- 1.16 the total cost. The amount necessary to pay the amount assessed by the commissioner
