5 BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the State of Minnesota, that it
6 retains the use of the Speaker's parking place in front of the capitol building just east of the
7 porte-cochère and parking lots B, C, D, N, O and the state office building parking ramp for
8 members and employees of the House of Representatives during the time between adjournment
9 in 2013 and the convening of the House of Representatives in 2014. The Sergeant at Arms is
10 directed to manage the use of the lots and ramp while the House of Representatives is adjourned.
11 The Controller of the House may continue to deduct from the check of any legislator or
12 legislative employee a sum adequate to cover the exercise of the parking privilege.
