## Rep. Masin announces support for emergency school aid proposal

St. Paul, Minn. – Following the release of Gov. Dayton's proposal to provide \$138 million in emergency aid to school districts around Minnesota, Rep. Sandra Masin, DFL-Eagan, released the following statement:

"School districts are facing budget deficits and potential cuts that could undermine the quality education we're committed to providing for our children. Gov. Dayton's proposal would provide much needed, one-time funding to districts across the state.

"Every Minnesotan deserves a world-class education and we must make the investments necessary to ensure that is a reality."

The proposal increases school resources by 2 percent, amounting to an individual \$126 for every student in Minnesota.

Funding increases for some of the impacted school districts are below:

Burnsville-Eagan-Savage Public School District \$1.4 million

Rosemount-Apple Valley-Eagan Public School District \$4.1 million

West St. Paul-Mendota Heights-Eagan \$770,410
