The 2017 regular legislative session ended very late Monday night and, unfortunately, 70 percent of the state's budget is still unresolved.

Republicans ran down the clock by walking away from negotiations in the last week and sending bills to Gov. Dayton they knew he wouldn't sign. Vital government services and the wellbeing of our families and neighbors are affected by their unwillingness to compromise and it's disappointing this continues to happen whenever they control the legislature.

On Monday, I spoke on the floor about the small cell wireless provision in the Jobs finance bill that can take control away from cities on negotiating with telecommunication companies over the placement of their infrastructure. This is another attempt by Republicans to strip local control away from our communities and residents. Their arrogance pits corporations against cities and communities.
