UNDERSTANDING IMMIGRATION: where we are, how we got here, and the impact on Minnesota communities

Minnesota's immigrant population has tripled since 1990. Today nearly 460,000 Minnesotans were born outside the U.S. – including an estimated 90,000 undocumented Minnesotans – and 1 in 6 Minnesota children have at least one immigrant parent. The presentation will explore the federal law and policies which govern the admission and expulsion of refugees and immigrants and identify how new immigration enforcement priorities impact Minnesota's communities.
