The House DFL Transportation budget makes critical investments to make our roads and bridges and transit systems safer.

In putting “One Minnesota” values into action, the House DFL Transportation budget delivers sustainable, dedicated, ongoing funding for roads, bridges, and transit over the next two years, investing more than \$1.1 billion in fixing our roads and bridges and more than \$1 billion to improve transit systems statewide.



Addressing the Climate Crisis

The transportation bill invests in public transit, electric vehicles, intercity passenger rail, funding for nonmotorized transportation options and emissions impact assessments.
