HOUSE DFL PRIORITIES

What's happened to Minnesota is unacceptable - the direct harm, fear, and disregard for humanity we've faced at the hands of the federal government cannot be ignored.

We're fighting for common-sense proposals to protect Minnesotans' constitutional rights, hold ICE agents accountable, and make sure nothing like this ever happens in the future. We're calling on our GOP colleagues to stand with Minnesotans, not against them. Even with a tied House, we could pass bills to protect our state if Republicans put people over politics and their blind loyalty to Donald Trump.

No ICE in public schools, childcare centers, or health care centers

DFL lawmakers are working to protect essential and sensitive places in our communities from federal agents. Minnesotans deserve safety in their everyday lives and shouldn't be threatened by their own federal government.

- **HF 3435 (Jordan):** Keep ICE away from school grounds
- **HF 3415 (Sencer-Mura):** Keep ICE away from childcare centers
- **TBD (Mahamoud):** Keep ICE away from hospitals
- **HF 3411 (Coulter):** Keep ICE away from college campuses

No Secret Police

This is America, and we don't have secret police. DFL lawmakers are working to hold federal agents to the standards of our state and local law enforcement agencies.

- **HF 3412 (Finke):** Mask ban for agents
- **HF 3358 (Finke):** Require vehicles that transport detainees to be marked as law enforcement, and restrict the use of civilian rental vehicles

ICE Accountability

DFL lawmakers are working to hold ICE agents accountable for unlawful tactics and for violating Minnesotans' constitutional rights.

- **HF 3414 (Long):** Give Minnesotans opportunity to defend their constitutional rights in civil court
- **TBD (F. Lee):** Restrictions on tear gas and flash bang grenades
- **HF 3405 (Moller):** Require BCA's participation in all law enforcement- or federal agent-involved shootings in Minnesota
- **HF 3483 (Feist):** Requires a judicial warrant to enter private property.
- **HF 3468 (Huot):** Duty to Render Aid

Protect Minnesotans' Privacy

Federal agents are using technology to invade Minnesotans' privacy. DFL lawmakers are working to safeguard privacy rights from future possible abuses.

- **TBD (Tabke):** Restrictions on use of Automatic License Plate Readers (ALPR)
