



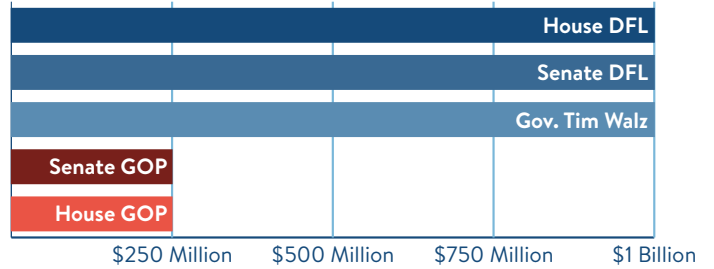
FRONTLINE WORKER BONUS PAY FACT SHEET

DFL vs. GOP



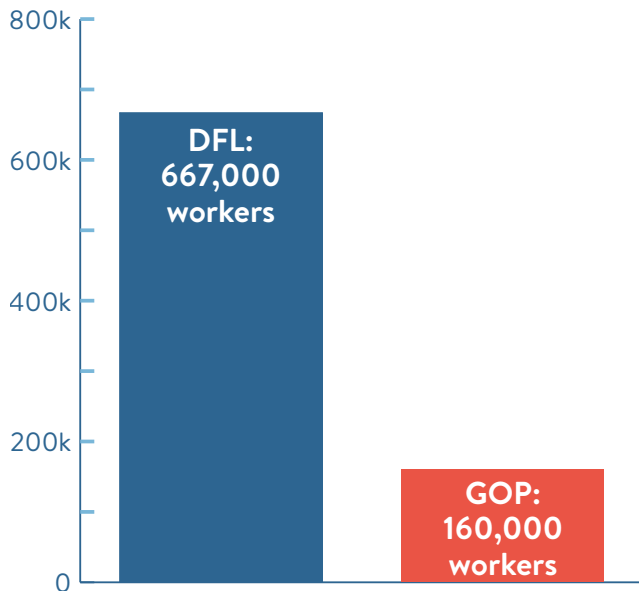
Who is a frontline worker?

The House DFL proposal includes the following occupations in the definition of a frontline worker:

1. Long-term care and home care
2. Health care
3. Emergency responders
4. Public health, social service, and regulatory service
5. Courts and corrections
6. Child care
7. Public schools, including charter schools, state schools, and higher education
8. Food service, including production, processing, preparation, sale, and delivery
9. Retail, including sales, fulfillment, distribution, and delivery
10. Temporary shelters and hotels
11. Building services, including maintenance, janitorial, and security
12. Public transit
13. Ground and air transportation services
14. Manufacturing
15. Vocational rehabilitation.
