## LEGISLATIVE AGENDA ACHIEVEMENTS

*The Minnesota House Queer Legislators Caucus was an undeniable force throughout the most consequential two-year session in state history. In the 2023 legislative session, the Queer Legislators Caucus led efforts to advance equity and create policies to ensure school facilities across the state had funding to create gender-inclusive restrooms. They were relentless in the pursuit of making Minnesota a refuge state for our LGBTQIA2S+, transgender, and nonbinary community. Building on their momentum, legislators diligently pursued legislation in the 2024 session to expand support for trans youth, secure grants for LGBTQIA2S+ small businesses and strengthening protections for our most vulnerable community members, and more!*
