- 1 Repealer.** Repeals section 214.12, subdivision 2. This subdivision requires the boards of dentistry, medical practice, nursing, chiropractic examiners, and podiatric medicine to require by rule that health occupations licensed by those boards receive continuing education on infection control, including blood borne diseases. The effect of repealing this subdivision is that these boards are no longer required to have rules requiring continuing education on infection control, unless a practice act of an individual occupation regulated by one of these boards requires rules on continuing education in infection control for that occupation.
