Overview

This act specifies that employees of certain nonprofit scientific organizations who engage in research or other activities are not engaging in the unlawful practice of medicine.

Exemption from medical licensing requirements. Amends § 147.09. Exempts, from the unlawful practice of medicine, a person employed by a tax-exempt, nonprofit organization operated primarily to conduct scientific research on causes of and cures for human disease if the person's duties are:

entirely of a research, public health, or educational character; and if the research includes the study of humans, conducted under the supervision of one or more licensed physicians.
