- 1 Emergency medical dispatching.** Adds to the list of instances in which local governments are exempt from tort liability; any claim based on acts or omissions of a 911 dispatcher who is certified by a program incorporating nationally recognized standards and who is acting in good faith while giving pre-arrival medical instructions that are based on emergency medical dispatch protocols adopted by the dispatching agency.
- 2 Effective date.** Immediate. Applies to causes of action arising on or after that date.
