Overview

Authorizes the Governor to veto proposed administrative rules before the rules take effect. This authority expires June 30, 2001.

- Veto of rules. Permits the governor to veto all or a severable portion of a rule within 14 days after the final rules is received from the secretary of state. This authority applies only if the agency would have authority to take this action. Requires the governor to notify chairs of appropriate legislative committees.
- **2-5 Transmittal to governor.** Requires adopted rules to be transmitted to the governor for review.
- **Sunset.** The rule veto authority expires June 30, 2001.
- **Effective date.** Effective the day following final enactment and applies to rules adopted on or after that date.
