## Overview

This act involves no-fault medical benefits under automobile insurance. The act adds sign interpreting and language translation to the list of medical benefits, when necessary in connection with other covered medical care.

- Medical Expense Benefits. Requires medical benefits under no-fault automobile insurance to cover the cost of sign interpreting and language translation related to the receipt of medical care. This does not include coverage for interpreting and translating done by relatives of the patient. Makes technical changes.
- **Effective Date.** Immediate effective date.
